TEF MINI GRANT GUIDELINES

OVERVIEW

The Tewksbury Education Foundation Mini Grant Program was established to provide teachers with a resource to enhance the education of their students. The Mini Grant Program is based on the belief that many successful programs begin in the classroom.

GUIDELINES:

- Grants will be awarded based on educational value, innovation, creativity, and benefit to students.
- Projects will be funded for a maximum of two consecutive years.*
- They must first be discussed with the School Principal, then by the TEF Mini Grant Committee, then by the Tewksbury Township Board of Education, and, lastly, by the TEF Board of Directors.

*Exceptions made on a case-by-case scenario. Final approval by the TEF Board of Directors is required.

GRANT PROPOSALS DEMONSTRATE:

- Creativity in meeting a specific curriculum challenge in the classroom
- Direct benefit to students and/or school which can be measured
- Provide unique and/or higher concept learning
- Capture students' interest
- Neatly constructed and clearly defined
