News You Can Use Jean Frankel Founder's Award

The TEF was created 24 years ago to enhance educational excellence in the Tewksbury Township School District. In that time, donations from families like yours have allowed for hundreds of enrichment programs in arts, STEM, literature and wellness to be delivered in classrooms from Kindergarten through 8th Grade.



To celebrate that support of excellence, each year the TEF honors one 8th grade student with a generous scholarship. In the spring, 8th grade students are given a comprehensive, blinded questionnaire that ask how they spend time outside of the classroom. Then, the TEF conducts a thorough, unbiased review of applications. The recipient will be announced at the 8th grade graduation ceremony and is chosen due to their focus and dedication in enhancing their own personal education.

This award is made possible thanks to one of the founding members of the Tewksbury Education Foundation, Jean Frankel. Jean and her husband, Gregg, have generously committed, through the Frankel Foundation, to fund the Jean Frankel Founder's Award for 20 years. The award, in the amount of \$2,500, will be given to the recipient upon their graduation from high school and is to be used toward their post-secondary school education. Past scholarship awardees

BJ Ward, Poet



Back by popular demand,
Poet BJ Ward will be
spending three days reading
and discussing poetry with
the third grade classes.
During the workshop,
students will publish their

own poem in a class booklet, discover poetry with assistance from a harmonica and silly glasses, and will read poems by Pulitzer Prize winning poets. BJ is loved by the students and staff at TES. He has a natural ability to connect with students and, through the years, he has instilled a passion for poetry in our young students.

BJ Ward is the author of Jackleg Opera: Collected Poems, 1990-2013, which received the Paterson Poetry Prize. As an author, BJ's poetry has been natioanally recognized. BJ is the recipient of a Pushcart Prize for Poetry and two Distinguished Artist Fellowships from the New Jersey State Council on the Arts. The Star-Ledger has named Ward one of the "10 Dynamic Jersey Artists Not Named Springsteen" who are "making a difference," citing his poetry's "music and physicality." As a teacher, BJ has received the Governor's Award in Arts Education from the State of New Jersey and has been designated Distinguished Teaching Artist by the New Jersey State Council on the Arts. In addition to receiving numerous other prestigious awards, he teaches at Warren County Community College in the Creative Writing program. In 2016, he was honored with the President's Merit Award at the Warren County Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony.

BJ lives near the Musconetcong River in Lebanon Township, NJ, with his partner, the writer Laurie Granieri, and his eleven year old son.

"I am looking forward to joining the Tewksbury Township School District in July. My goal is to support the teaching and learning in this exceptional learning community by building strong relationships with teachers, parents, students, and the broader Tewksbury community.

I will strive to continue to improve the education of our students based on my knowledge of best practices in teaching. My doctoral work at the University of Pennsylvania has prepared me to take on a top leadership job in a school district. My graduate studies at Bank Street College allowed me to gain a deep understanding of childhood and adolescent development. My educational interests include teacher professional learning and international education. I have traveled to Japan to learn about how educators there work together to improve teaching and learning.

My experience includes being an Assistant Superintendent, a Director of Curriculum and Instruction, a K-12 Supervisor of Mathematics, and a middle school and high school math teacher. I received a doctorate in education from the University of Pennsylvania, a masters degree in Mathematics Leadership from Bank Street College in NYC, and an undergraduate degree in Mathematics Education from Penn State. I believe my experience and education will help me lead others to improve schools and schooling for all."
