### News You Can Use TEF Mini Grants



The Tewksbury Education Foundation is very proud of the funding that we've been able to provide through mini grants to teachers and staff in our school district to pursue unique or special programs and/or purchase equipment that wouldn't otherwise be possible through the school's budget. The TEF mini grant budget of \$5,000 has been used to fund some incredible programs over the past few years including bringing Holocaust survivors to speak with our 5th - 8th graders, purchasing portable sound systems for both OTS and TES, increasing the number of instruments available to students by purchasing an oboe, two baritones and eighteen ukuleles, as well as purchasing sensory tools at TES including wobble stools, gel balls, bouncy bands for chairs, noise cancelling headphones and seat cushions to maximize student engagement and focus during lessons. Students at OTS have benefitted from flexible seating as well as a jigsaw puzzle table and wobble stools for the OTS library for students to decompress during classes and take a break from technology. Our most recent mini grantee will purchase the Swivl Program, which is a video review and collaboration

Survivors Speak is a program developed by the Holocaust

Council of Greater MetroWest as part of their outreach to schools. This program will highlight Dr. Carl Dubovy, an eyewitness to the Holocaust (survivors, liberators, POWs). Dr. Dubovy was chosen for the diversity of his experiences during the Holocaust. He will address 5-8<sup>th</sup> grade students to share his experiences with a question and answer session to follow. This program supplements the Holocaust and Genocide Studies curriculum provided to students in grades 5-8<sup>th</sup> and is sponsored by a TEF mini grant which was awarded to Mrs. Cathy Zisk, 6th grade Social Studies teacher at OTS. Eric Eisenhart has collaborated with the TEF to develop and administer an important wellness initiative. Since the program was launched in 2016, Eric and the team at Pro-Activity have run and stood alongside of the Tewksbury school community at the Tiger Trot and they will be at the finish line again this June for the 5<sup>th</sup> race – the new King of the Hill 5K. American poet, BJ Ward, has been a presence in Tewksbury schools for over a decade, consistently sought after by countless teachers and students who look forward to what lies ahead when BJ enters the classroom. These providers have become an integral part of the curriculum and the TEF hopes that Tewksbury students continue to benefit from their expertise for many years to come.
